### About the Sculpture Trail Project

Waveney & Blyth Arts is excited to be planning its fifth Sculpture Trail in the Waveney Valley, part of 'Celebrate Waveney & Blyth 2018', an annual programme of events that highlight the unique character of the two valleys situated in north Suffolk and south Norfolk. Following a very successful year at the new Raveningham Centre venue, which attracted 45 artists, over 3000 visitors and £12,000 art sales in 2017, we are delighted to return to Raveningham for 2018.

The Raveningham Centre offers opportunities for site specific work and sculpture in the grounds of Castell Farm, a Tudor farmhouse with an old orchard, meadows and gardens. The Ravenous Cafe is on site and will feature an exhibition of works by Harleston and Waveney Art Trail with further works by artists in the farmhouse gallery. ### Raveningham Sculpture Trail 2018

Having spent a huge amount of time preparing the site at Raveningham in 2017 we now have the task of creating a new show with established paths and new meadow areas. Many artists enjoyed the scale of the site at Raveningham with its numerous natural rooms and secret pockets of space. For 2018 the Curator, Sarah Cannell, is particularly interested in applications from artists who will respond to the space and create site specific works. This could be in any medium and there is the opportunity to work to a large scale in some of the open meadows and wooded areas. We have an exciting opportunity here to create something positive, celebrating the power of the arts to engage, inspire and educate a diverse audience. There is also our continued drive to continue to encourage public interaction with contemporary art in a rural setting.

Commission on sales is 30% which goes towards management of the event and supports other Waveney & Blyth Arts projects. There will be a good opportunity to sell cards, prints and books in the cafe and shop. This year there will be two awards for participating artists, The Visitor's Choice £400 and The Curator's Choice £400.

- 4 - A non-returnable Application Fee of £15 (free for W&BA members). Your application fee includes a 1 year membership of W&BA.
