Did you know that until 8000 years ago Britain was a part of Europe, linked by a fertile low-lying plain? Or that there was a great flood that caused Britain to become an island? Or that close-knit communities had to uproot themselves and make new homes in distant lands?

The story of Doggerland, the land now covered by the North Sea, has only come to light in the last fifty years or so, unearthed by dredgers and oil exploration surveys.

Come and hear stories about the lost land. Imagine that you were there, in a roundhouse of wood and earth, sharing stories about hunting vicious boar and wild wolves, of magical groves and sacred pools, and of people's struggle as the sea flooded, changing their way of life for ever.
